APPLICATION AND ADMISSION INFORMATION

Dear Parents

When looking for a school for your children, fees and affordability play an ever-increasing role in selection. At Wembley College we introduced a system in 2004 whereby all fees are paid by the debit order system. This has made it a lot easier for parents to ensure that fees are paid timeously and the daunting task of collecting fees is made a lot easier for the school. Please note that a completed debit order form must be submitted when applying for a position at Wembley College.

APPLICATION /ADMISSION FEES

An acceptance fee of one month's current school fees and boarding fees (if applicable) are payable upon acceptance. This is a non-refundable fee that will be credited to your Wembley College account. This acceptance fee will be adjusted in January according to the increased fees for the new year. January fees are due on the first day of school, as school and boarding fees are payable in advance.

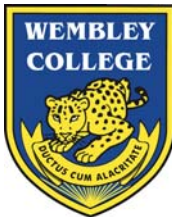

NOTICE PERIOD

A full term's written notice is required in the event that any scholar leaves the College or the Boarding Establishment before completing Form 6, failing which a quarter's fees will be payable in lieu of notice.

DEBIT ORDER SYSTEM

Please specify your choice of payment per 10 month/term/half-yearly or annually. If fees are paid **annually in advance** by the first school day, a **discount of 5%** will be applicable; if paid by the second school day a **discount of 2.5%**; and if paid thereafter no discount will apply. Should you wish to increase your debit order to include 'extras', please let us have a separate letter authorising us to do so and stating the increased amount.

A 2.5% handling fee is charged on debit orders. If a debit order is not signed, a letter stating how payment will be made is required and a handling fee of 5% will be charged monthly. A R50.00 levy will be charged for each **dishonoured debit order**. To cancel your debit order, please advise Wembly College in writing one month in advance. Debit orders cannot be charged to credit cards.

CREDIT CARD FACILITIES

For parents with credit or debit cards, please note that we have a card machine in the accounts office.

SPECIAL REDUCTIONS

For the second family member a reduction of 5% is granted. For a third family member a reduction of 10% is granted and for the fourth and any additional family member(s), a reduction of 15% is applicable.

PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE FUND

It is compulsory for all pupils to belong to the KZN Scholars' Personal Accident Fund. It is a once off payment for the year and will be charged to your account at the beginning of the year. The costs of the fund are listed below:

INTEREST

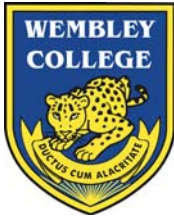
Interest of 2% per month is charged on outstanding amounts. Any costs borne by the College to follow up on unpaid fees will be charged to the account of the parent/guardian including cell-phone calls, faxes etc.

EXTRAS & SUPPLEMENTARY FEES (BOARDING ESTABLISHMENT SCHOLARS)

Charges for special medicines, private use of transport, stationery, dry cleaning, purchases from the school Uniform Shop and other incidentals such as examination fees or private tuition in music and other subjects will be reflected on the end of term accounts. Doctors' consultation fees are charged directly to parents by the medical practitioner. Accounts for supplementary fees or expenses shall be paid within FOURTEEN (14) days of date of posting.

STATIONERY & TEXT BOOKS

School fees do not include text books and stationery. A list of textbooks and stationery is available from the office per grade/form.

REPATRIATION FEE (FOR NON-SOUTH AFRICAN RESIDENTS)

Due to Government Regulations, the College requires a full term's fees to be held as a refundable deposit in case of repatriation. This fee will be refunded when the scholar leaves Wembley College. This arrangement excludes scholars from Namibia, Lesotho and Swaziland.

ATTORNEYS' FEES

In the event of Wembley having to hand over outstanding fees after 120 days for collection, both parents are liable for all attorney and collection costs.
